



THE OLD QUAY HOUSE HOTEL DOG POLICY

The Old Quay House Hotel, we are happy to welcome well behaved friendly pups. We do however ask that owners follow the following guidelines when bringing their dogs along to stay with them, to ensure the comfort for yourself, your furry friend, and our fellow guests.

- A £15 per dog per night fee is charged for your dog to stay at The Old Quay House Hotel. If your dog has been a little naughty and the rooms require maintenance or cleaning from this, there will be a surcharge for this.
- We allow one dog per family in our first-floor rooms (rooms 1 – 6)
- We are unfortunately unable to allow pets in our dining room at present.
- We are happy for your dog to be left unattended in their rooms, if you are confident that they won't become stressed in their new environment. If your dog isn't happy to be left, we can allocate the lounge area as a safe dining space for you and your pet.
- We don't allow dogs on our furniture or beds so please remember to pack a suitable bedding area for your furry friend.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times within public areas.
- Please remember to clean up after your pet.
- Please be mindful of other guests in the hotel as some guests may be wary of dogs.
- Please contact Reception at extension '0' to arrange for a convenient time for your room to be serviced. For the safety and comfort of your pet, Housekeeping will only enter your room if either your dog is not present or if you are present and your dog is on a lead.
